

## Transport Options

### Travelling to and from Prince of Wales Hospital

#### Public Transport

- There are a number of bus services that stop near Prince of Wales Hospital.

These include: 314, 316, 317, 348, 370, 372, 373, 376, 400, and M50.

- The light rail line L2 runs from Circular Quay and Central Station with the last stop outside Prince of Wales Hospital.

## Community Transport Options

Community transport services can take you and your carer/s to your medical appointments if:

- you are financially disadvantaged, isolated, lack public transport or have a mobility impairment
- you are an older people who is frail
- you are a person with disabilities.

Clients must request transport at least two working days in advance.

## Transport to use our cancer services

If you are receiving cancer treatment or attending oncology appointments at our Hospital you can access these transport services:

### Prince of Wales Oncology Bus and Nelune Foundation

- To enquire, speak with administration staff in the Oncology Department, or call 9382 5111, or ask your Social Worker.
- You need to make a booking for transport at least a day before your appointment.

### Leukaemia Foundation

- If you have blood cancer, this service can take you to and from your treatment.

- You need to make a booking for transport at least 48 hours before your treatment.
