This is how we do it

1. We will think about child safety in everything we do.		"I always feel safe here"
2. We will listen to you and include you when we make decisions about you.		"The people caring for me here will hear me out and respect what I say"
3. We will work with the people that are important to you to keep you safe.		"The workers talk to the people that care about me to make sure I am okay"
4. We see you for who you are and will treat you with respect. We will make sure that we give you the care that you need and care that makes you feel safe.		"People treat me fairly here and give me the help I need"
5. People who work here know how to look after you and keep you safe.		"People here genuinely care about my wellbeing. I can ask questions, and they will always try to answer"
6. We want to know if you are worried or scared. You can speak to us, and we will listen.		"I feel comfortable to share my feelings and worries. The adults here will listen to me and try to help deal with the situation"
7. We will keep on learning about the best ways to keep you safe.		"The workers here are always learning the best ways to look after me"
8. We want to make all our physical and online spaces feel safe for you.		"The staff will keep an eye out for me to make sure I am okay"
9. We want to hear what you think about us and your ideas about how we can do better. We use these ideas to make sure you are well looked after.		"The staff here are happy to get feedback to keep making things better"
10. We will write down your ideas and our plans so that everyone knows what to do to keep you well looked after.		"Clear rules tell everybody how to best look after me"
