Information about COVID-19 testing clinics

社區的COVID-19檢測覆蓋率依然較低。

如出現癥狀，應接受檢測，防止將COVID-19傳染他人。

我應該接受檢測嗎？

- 如果您出現了相關癥狀，就應該接受檢測。癥狀包括：發燒、咳嗽、喉嚨痛/痕癢、呼吸急促、失去味覺或嗅覺。
- 即使您戴口罩且不太接觸人，出現癥狀也需要接受檢測。

檢測過程安全嗎？

- 檢測機構清潔和安全。您可以放心接受檢測。

檢測需要花錢嗎？我需要有Medicare卡才能接受檢測嗎？

- 如果是公立機構，檢測是免費的。接受檢測不需要Medicare卡。

哪些地方可以接受檢測？

- 有很多機構可接受檢測。點擊下面網址了解新州的檢測機構。

- 如果是公立機構，您可以直接前往，不需要預約。
- 有些檢測機構您可以直接去。有些則需要在車裏接受檢測。
- 可提供口譯服務。您到達之後，檢測機構會安排電話口譯員。
- 您也可以向GP（家庭醫生）諮詢檢測事宜。GP會給您安排。

兒童可以接受檢測嗎？

- 兒童可以接受檢測。
- 有些機構不對幼兒進行檢測。您可以打電話到相關機構諮詢，或在新州衛生部官網查閱檢測的最低年齡限制：

檢測需要花很長時間嗎？

- 檢測非常快。
- 如果機構人多，您可能需要等一等。

我如何得知檢測結果？

- 大多數檢測結果會通過短信通知，您也可以撥打檢測機構的電話詢問。一般情況下，24小時內就能出結果。
- 如果您的檢測結果呈陽性，檢測機構會給您打電話。

接受檢測之後我應該做什麼？

- 拿到結果之前應進行自我隔離，也就是必須待在家中，避免與他人接觸。

如果我被檢查出感染COVID-19，該怎麼辦？

- 我們會給您打電話，問您幾個問題，然後告訴您應該怎麼做。
- 您需要在家隔離14天，避免與他人接觸。
- 大多數人不需要去醫院或隔離酒店。
- 國家醫療系統會給予您支持。如需入院治療，費用可全免。

- Hurstville檢測機構可以為殘障人士和有其他特殊需求的人進行檢測。
- Hurstville檢測機構可針對五歲及以上的兒童進行檢測。嬰幼兒和學齡前兒童可在St George醫院接受檢測。
- 如果您需要前往Hurstville檢測機構在自己的車裏接受檢測，應先電話聯系他們。您可以通過傳譯員聯系Hurstville檢測機構。
- 撥打 131 450 聯系翻譯局申請口譯員。告訴傳譯員您需要聯系Hurstville檢測機構。Hurstville檢測機構的電話是 9113 2150。
- Hurstville檢測機構的地址是 34 Woniora Rd, Hurstville。工作時間：週一至週五，上午9點至下午4點。

Information about COVID-19 testing clinics

Not enough people in the community are getting tested for COVID-19.

Everyone with symptoms needs to get tested to help stop the community spread of COVID-19.

Should I get tested?

- If you have any symptoms you should get tested. Symptoms include fever, cough, sore/ scratchy throat, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell.
- Even if you wear a mask and don't see many people, you should still get tested if you have symptoms.

Is it safe to get tested?

- The testing clinics are clean and safe. It is safe to get tested.

Do I have to pay to get tested? Do I need a Medicare card to get tested?

- In a public clinic, it is free to get tested. You don't need a Medicare card.

Where can I get tested?

- There are many testing clinics. This website shows the testing clinics in NSW:

- You can just turn up at a public clinic. You don't need to make an appointment.
- Some clinics you can walk into. Other clinics are drive-through clinics.
- Interpreters are available. The clinic can arrange a telephone interpreter when you arrive.
- You can also ask your GP (local doctor) about testing. GPs can arrange testing.

Can children get tested?

- Yes, children can get tested.
- Some clinics may not test very young children. You can call the clinic or check the NSW Health website for age limits:

Does it take long to get tested?

- The test is very quick.
- If the clinic is busy you might need to wait to be tested

How will I get my results?

- Most test results are sent by text message or you can call the number provided by the clinic. Most results are available in less than 24 hours.
- If your test is positive, the health service will call you.

What happens after I get tested?

- You need to self-isolate until you get your results. This means you need to stay at home, away from other people.

What happens if I have COVID-19?

- We will call you, ask you more questions, and tell you what to do.
- You will need to stay home for 14 days, away from other people.
- Most people don't need to go to hospital or a quarantine hotel.
- The health system will support you. If you need treatment in hospital there will be no cost to you.

Where are the testing clinics in South Eastern Sydney?

- Hurstville Clinic can test people with disabilities and other special needs.
- Testing available at the Hurstville Clinic for children five years and older. Babies, toddlers and pre-school age children can be tested at St George Hospital.
- If you need to get tested in your car at the Hurstville Clinic then you need to call them first. You can call the Hurstville Clinic through an interpreter.
- Call the Translating & Interpreting Service on 131 450 and ask for an interpreter in your language. Tell the interpreter that you want to call the Hurstville Clinic. The Hurstville Clinic phone number is 9113 2150.
- The Hurstville Clinic is at 34 Woniora Rd, Hurstville. They are open Monday to Friday, 9.00am to 4.00pm.
