

# Informasi mengenai klinik pengujian COVID-19

## Information about COVID-19 testing clinics

Indonesian

**Jumlah anggota masyarakat yang menjalani tes COVID-19 masih kurang memadai.**

**Siapa pun yang merasakan gejala perlu menjalani tes untuk membantu menghentikan penyebaran COVID-19 dalam masyarakat.**

### Apakah saya perlu menjalani tes?

- Anda harus menjalani tes jika Anda merasakan gejala COVID-19. Gejalanya termasuk demam, batuk, tenggorokan sakit/gatal, sesak napas, kehilangan indera perasa atau penciuman.
- Biarpun Anda mengenakan masker dan tidak bertemu banyak orang, Anda tetap harus menjalani tes kalau merasakan gejala.

### Apakah aman untuk menjalani tes?

- Klinik pengujian bersih dan aman. Menjalani tes itu aman.

### Apakah saya perlu memiliki kartu Medicare?

- Pada klinik umum, tes COVID-19 gratis. Anda tidak perlu memiliki kartu Medicare.

### Di mana sajakah saya dapat menjalani tes?

- Klinik pengujian banyak jumlahnya. Situs web ini menunjukkan lokasi klinik pengujian di NSW:

- Anda dapat datang ke klinik umum tanpa perlu membuat janji temu.
- Sebagian klinik membolehkan Anda berjalan masuk. Sebagian lagi adalah klinik lantatur (drive-through).
- Layanan juru bahasa tersedia. Klinik dapat menghubungi juru bahasa melalui telepon ketika Anda tiba.
- Anda juga dapat bertanya kepada dokter GP (dokter setempat) Anda tentang tes. Dokter GP dapat mengurus tes.

### Apakah anak-anak dapat menjalani tes?

- Ya, anak-anak dapat menjalani tes.
- Sebagian klinik tidak melakukan tes bagi anak yang masih sangat kecil. Anda dapat menelepon klinik tersebut atau memeriksa batas umur di situs web NSW Health:

### Apakah tes COVID-19 memakan waktu lama?

- Tes ini sangat cepat.
- Jika klinik sibuk Anda mungkin harus menunggu untuk dites.

### Bagaimana saya akan mendapatkan hasil tes?

- Sebagian besar hasil tes dikirim melalui SMS atau Anda dapat menelepon nomor yang diberikan oleh klinik. Sebagian besar hasil tes keluar kurang dari 24 jam.
- Jika hasil tes Anda positif, petugas layanan kesehatan akan menelepon Anda.

### Apa yang terjadi setelah saya menjalani tes?

- Anda perlu mengisolasi diri sampai hasilnya keluar. Ini berarti Anda harus tinggal di rumah, jauh dari orang lain.

### Bagaimana jika saya mengidap COVID-19?

- Kami akan menelepon Anda, mengajukan pertanyaan lebih lanjut, dan memberitahu Anda apa yang harus dilakukan.
- Anda harus tetap di rumah selama 14 hari, jauh dari orang lain.
- Sebagian besar orang tidak perlu pergi ke rumah sakit atau hotel karantina.
- Sistem kesehatan akan membantu Anda. Jika Anda perlu perawatan di rumah sakit, Anda tidak akan dikenai biaya.

- Hurstville Clinic dapat melakukan tes bagi penyandang disabilitas dan orang berkebutuhan khusus.
- Hurstville Clinic dapat melakukan tes bagi anak-anak berusia lima tahun atau lebih. Bayi dan anak-anak di bawah lima tahun dapat menjalani tes di St George Hospital (Rumah Sakit St George).
- Jika Anda perlu menjalani tes di dalam mobil Anda di Hurstville Clinic maka Anda perlu menelepon terlebih dahulu. Anda dapat menelepon Hurstville Clinic dengan bantuan juru bahasa.
- Hubungilah Layanan Penerjemahan dan Juru Bahasa di 131 450 lalu mintalah juru bahasa untuk bahasa Anda. Beritahukan juru bahasa bahwa Anda ingin menelepon Hurstville Clinic. Nomor telepon Hurstville Clinic adalah 9113 2150.
- Hurstville Clinic berlokasi di 34 Woniora Rd, Hurstville dan buka dari Senin hingga Jumat, pukul 9.00 pagi hingga 4.00 sore.

# Information about COVID-19 testing clinics

**Not enough people in the community are getting tested for COVID-19.**

**Everyone with symptoms needs to get tested to help stop the community spread of COVID-19.**

## Should I get tested?

- If you have any symptoms you should get tested. Symptoms include fever, cough, sore/ scratchy throat, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell.
- Even if you wear a mask and don't see many people, you should still get tested if you have symptoms.

## Is it safe to get tested?

- The testing clinics are clean and safe. It is safe to get tested.

## Do I have to pay to get tested? Do I need a Medicare card to get tested?

- In a public clinic, it is free to get tested. You don't need a Medicare card.

## Where can I get tested?

- There are many testing clinics. This website shows the testing clinics in NSW:

- You can just turn up at a public clinic. You don't need to make an appointment.
- Some clinics you can walk into. Other clinics are drive-through clinics.
- Interpreters are available. The clinic can arrange a telephone interpreter when you arrive.
- You can also ask your GP (local doctor) about testing. GPs can arrange testing.

## Can children get tested?

- Yes, children can get tested.
- Some clinics may not test very young children. You can call the clinic or check the NSW Health website for age limits:

## Does it take long to get tested?

- The test is very quick.
- If the clinic is busy you might need to wait to be tested

## How will I get my results?

- Most test results are sent by text message or you can call the number provided by the clinic. Most results are available in less than 24 hours.
- If your test is positive, the health service will call you.

## What happens after I get tested?

- You need to self-isolate until you get your results. This means you need to stay at home, away from other people.

## What happens if I have COVID-19?

- We will call you, ask you more questions, and tell you what to do.
- You will need to stay home for 14 days, away from other people.
- Most people don't need to go to hospital or a quarantine hotel.
- The health system will support you. If you need treatment in hospital there will be no cost to you.

- Hurstville Clinic can test people with disabilities and other special needs.
- Testing available at the Hurstville Clinic for children five years and older. Babies, toddlers and pre-school age children can be tested at St George Hospital.
- If you need to get tested in your car at the Hurstville Clinic then you need to call them first. You can call the Hurstville Clinic through an interpreter.
- Call the Translating & Interpreting Service on 131 450 and ask for an interpreter in your language. Tell the interpreter that you want to call the Hurstville Clinic. The Hurstville Clinic phone number is 9113 2150.
- The Hurstville Clinic is at 34 Woniora Rd, Hurstville. They are open Monday to Friday, 9.00am to 4.00pm.
