Calvary is one of the largest sub-acute hospitals in NSW serving approximately 12,500 patients per year.

## Transition Framework

Calvary provides a twelve month, full time GradStart program rotating through both Palliative Care and Rehabilitation/Aged Care in a nurturing and encouraging environment so that you develop and reach your full potential. During this time you will be supported by the Calvary nursing team including Clinical Nurse Educators, Nurse Managers and the Nurse Manager; Education. You will receive a comprehensive General Orientation and Clinical Orientation Program and supernumerary days at the commencement of each rotation. You will be employed on a 7 day rotating roster. Throughout your transitioning year you will receive regular in-service education and clinical supervision sessions.
