Why St George and Sutherland

The St George and Sutherland Hospital Maternity Unit's combined offer a comprehensive maternity service with varied models of midwifery care for the residents of Sutherland Shire and the St George area across both sites.

Both St George and Sutherland Hospitals provide a variety of innovative midwifery models of care. These include Midwifery Group Practice (MGP), Culturally Specific Centering, Midwifery Antenatal and Postnatal Service (MAPS), Active Birth Team and Student Led Midwifery Group Practices. There are also complex high risk medical models of care at St George Hospital.

St George Hospital is located in Southern Sydney and is a Level 5+ maternity unit that provides maternity care to a culturally diverse population. St George also provides care for women whose pregnancy is either low to high risk. St George will birth approximately 2500 babies per year.

Sutherland Hospital is located in the Sutherland Shire and is a Level 4 maternity unit. Sutherland Hospital provides care to a less culturally diverse population group whose pregnancy is primarily low risk.

Type of employment

Sutherland Hospital and St George Hospital offer temporary full-time employment during the Registered Midwife GradStart year.

Transition Framework

St George Hospital / Sutherland Hospital is offering a twelve-month rotational program for newly graduated midwives who have completed the Bachelor of Midwifery.

There is an extensive orientation which also includes supernumerary clinical orientation days and study days tailored to your clinical needs.

Participants undertake rotations at both St George and Sutherland hospitals. Each rotation includes a Birth Unit and Antenatal/Postnatal in-patient ward rotation at each site. The graduate is also allocated to an Antenatal Clinic rotation at either St George OR Sutherland Hospital.

All midwifery graduates are allocated study days where they are supported with the education to further develop their midwifery skills and knowledge. We offer a supportive learning environment, which provides our graduates with a range of clinical experience with the aim of consolidating your midwifery training. All clinical areas are supported by a midwifery clinical educator and an overarching midwifery educator to assist with support and clinical practice.

The aim of the GradStart program is to ensure that by the end of the year, our newly Registered Midwives have been provided with an opportunity to consolidate their midwifery clinical skills and knowledge within a structured and supported program.

There is no on-site accommodation at either hospital.

St George Hospital is close to both rail and bus services. Kogarah is the closest railway station and is only a five minute walk from the hospital campus. There is adequate street parking within a 15 minute walk or available in an onsite public carparks.

Sutherland Hospital is a 10 to 15 minute walk to either Caringbah or Miranda railway stations. Sydney Central Business District is 30 minutes by train. There is adequate street parking within a 10minute walk or available in an onsite public carpark.
