Sydney Hospital and Sydney Eye Hospital (SSEH) is located on the site of Australia's first Hospital.

Sydney Hospital provides general and specialist health care to the public and community including 24 hour emergency care services, general medicine including a close observation unit, peri-operative services, day surgery and specialist hand surgery. Sydney Hospital's dedicated Hand Unit is a centre of excellence and tertiary referral centre for hand trauma, abnormalities and diseases of the hand.

Sydney Eye Hospital is a centre of excellence and quaternary referral centre for eye health conditions. It performs a vast amount of public eye surgery and provides emergency eye care, ophthalmic health services for inpatient/ outpatient and community outreach programs.

The Transition to Professional Practice General Stream provides you with an opportunity to undertake two rotations in a variety of units/departments during the 12 month program. We also offer a Perioperative Stream.

This Transition to Professional Practice (TPP) Registered Nurse Program – General Stream, is designed to develop and enhance your skills and knowledge as a first year Registered Nurse to implement safe, quality patient care within a supported clinical learning environment.

We take great pride in enabling transitioning nurses to develop as competent, responsible and accountable Registered Nurses.

Our Transition to Professional Practice Framework is committed to a **person centered and facilitated learning** approach whereby you as the transitioning nurse continue to be self determining and responsible for your learning and professional development.

By selecting the Sydney Hospital/Sydney Eye Hospital General Stream Program, our Transition to Professional Practice Framework offers the following:-

- Nursing experience in a specialist teaching hospital in the heart of Sydney
- Five day corporate and tailored nursing orientation program
- Two rotations from a variety of clinical wards/units over a 12 month period
- Ongoing support, guidance and facilitation from preceptors and other clinical resource staff including clinical nurse educators, nurse educator, clinical nurse consultants and a nurse manager who is responsible for the implementation and management of the Transition to Professional Practice Program and its underpinning core principles
- A regular program of first year transitioning nurse tailored education sessions, including access to the hospital wide in-service program, and closed group Clinical Supervision to support reflective practice.

- NSW Health State-wide uniforms
