- War Memorial Hospital is a unique sub-acute public hospital operating within South Eastern Sydney Local health District, owned by Uniting.
- We specialise in the provision of dynamic aged rehabilitation services to clients over 65 years old and support them to transition from in-patient hospital care back to the community through an integrated care approach. Our 35 bed in-patient unit is comprehensively staffed by 24/7 specialist aged rehabilitation nurses and fully supported by the specialist interdisciplinary team of Geriatricians and the full range of Allied Health services.
- Our in-patient hub forms part of the broader campus suite of services which includes various specialist community teams, a range of outpatient allied health services, specialist clinics, health promotion services, all devoted to the delivery of person-centred, high quality care to the older adult.
- We are a highly skilled rehabilitation nursing team committed to advocating for our clients in achieving
 excellence in client centred outcomes whilst upholding the Australian Rehabilitation Nurses Association
 Standards. We provide a culture of nurturing, encouragement and support in a learning environment offering you
 every potential to flourish and strengthen your clinical skills and professional development.

Transition Framework

We offer a contemporary, challenging and dynamic GradStart program to 3 successful applicants every year. The WMH experience offers newly graduated nurses the opportunity to develop and consolidate their comprehensive clinical, client and family assessment skills from a holistic perspective. This foundational year will provide a strong platform for future professional direction. The unique insight into integrated healthcare pathways inclusive of patient journey from the acute to sub-acute and back to community, will prove invaluable in the future growth of health service delivery outside of the traditional hospital setting.

The program includes:

- Robust, evidenced based training program with a designated preceptor in your first three months, including 2 day hospital orientation and 1 day unit orientation and supernumerary shifts with senior nurses
- Education and training provided to use and operate the electronic medical record and medication system

- Formal check in points with performance development plans to ensure personal and professional goal achievement that is inclusive of debriefing and clinical supervision
- Allocated placement shifts to experience care provision by specialist WMH Community teams and services
- Rostering and leave entitlements in line with NSW Health policies and guidelines, supported by the War Memorial Hospital Nurses Agreement, WMH Nurse Wellness activities and access to SESLHD Employee Assistance Program

As you GROW

You will be actively encouraged to further your learning and professional skills by attending regular internal education programs and undertaking external courses and workshops (e.g. SESLHD, professional colleges). We also provide you with opportunities to test your own knowledge and skills in practice through mentoring, teaching and supporting nursing students in the clinical environment in the second half of the program.

Specialist WMH services with whom you spend supernumerary time include:

- Geriatric Flying Squad- a rapid response multidisciplinary team who provide comprehensive geriatric assessments, treatment and case coordination for older people residing in the community
- Aged Care Assessment Team- part of SESLHD Aged Care Assessment Programme, one of four ACAT hubs within the district, offering comprehensive aged care assessment services
- Transitional Aged Care- offering a superior multidisciplinary community and residential re-ablement package program
- Young Onset Dementia Program- provides a community based respite service with a coordinated approach to promote health and wellbeing of younger people (45-65years) living with dementia
