As a new Registered Nurse, our supportive and challenging program will give you the opportunity to develop and consolidate your clinical skills thus providing you with a fulfilling introduction and firm foundation to your ongoing career as a Registered Nurse.

You will be supported by the Calvary nursing team including Nurse Managers, Nurse Educators and the broader Calvary staff. You will receive a comprehensive General Orientation and Clinical Orientation Program and supernumerary days at the commencement of each rotation. Throughout your transitioning year you will receive regular in-service education and clinical supervision sessions.

Calvary Health Care Kogarah is a public hospital local to St George and Sutherland Shire regions with extensive Community Health Services to the St George region. The hospital sits within South Eastern Sydney Local Health District as an affiliated organisation.

Calvary Health Care Kogarah is one of the largest sub-acute hospitals in NSW serving approximately 12,500 patients per year. The hospital is set within lush and private gardens to enhance the wellbeing of our patients, their families and our staff.

- Management of patients with complex symptoms
- Development of knowledge and skills in pain management

- Participation in ongoing skill competencies and knowledge development.

## Other details

You will receive specialised orientation to the organisation, facility, and ward. This includes supernumerary status at the commencement of each of your clinical rotations. You are provided with flexible rostering on a 7-day rotating roster.

There is no on-site staff accommodation at Calvary Healthcare Kogarah.

There is free parking on site.

The nearest railway station is Kogarah, and a bus stop is located on Rocky Point Road, directly outside the hospital.
