Our hospital and program

Sydney Hospital and Sydney Eye Hospital (SSEH) is located on the site of Australia's first Hospital – right in the heart of the vibrant city of Sydney!

Services include 24-hour emergency care, inpatient general medicine (including a close observation unit and care of patients for misuse of drugs and alcohol), inpatient and outpatient ophthalmology and hand specialist services, in addition to peri-operative services, including day surgery.

SSEH is a teaching hospital and centre of excellence for ophthalmology and hands, providing health services for both inpatients and outpatients. It is a quaternary referral centre for eye health conditions, performing a vast amount of public eye surgery and providing emergency eye care. The dedicated Hand Unit is a tertiary referral centre for hand trauma, conditions and diseases of the hand.

The Transition to Professional Practice - General Stream, provides you with an opportunity to undertake two rotations in a variety of departments/units/wards during the 12-month program at SSEH.

Full-Time and Part-Time (subject to availability) positions are available.

We also offer Perioperative, Metro Rural Exchange, SSEH and POWH Exchange, and Population and Community Health Transitioning to Professional Practice Streams.

Transition Framework

Our Transition to Professional Practice Framework incorporates the four core transition principles of induction, person-centred work culture, learning and development, and support.

The Registered Nurse Program – General Stream, is designed to develop and enhance your skills and knowledge as a first year Registered Nurse to implement safe, quality, compassionate, and person-centred care within a supported, clinical learning environment. We take great pride in enabling transitioning nurses to develop as competent, confident, responsible and accountable Registered Nurses.

We are committed to a person-centred and facilitated learning approach, whereby you as the transitioning nurse continue to be self-determining and responsible for your learning and professional development.

By selecting Sydney Hospital and Sydney Eye Hospital - General Stream, our program offers you the following:

- Nursing experience in a specialist teaching hospital in the heart of Sydney
- Five day corporate and tailored nursing orientation program, followed by local unit orientation
- Two rotations from a variety of clinical departments/units/wards over a 12-month period
- Ongoing support, guidance and facilitation of learning from preceptors and other clinical resource staff, including clinical nurse educators, a nurse educator, clinical nurse consultants and a nurse manager who is responsible for the implementation and management of the Transition to Professional Practice Program
- A regular schedule of education sessions specifically designed for Transition to Professional Practice Nurses, including access to the hospital wide in-service program, Study Leave and closed group Reflective Practice Supervision to support your wellbeing.
- NSW Health State-wide uniforms
- Annual Leave
- Individualised career pathway planning and development
- Certificate of Achievement on completion of the Transition to Professional Practice Program - General Stream
- Nursing employment following completion of the program in a department/unit/ward based on position availability
