





# **Effective & Clinical Leadership Programs**

#### What is it?

The Leadership program runs over a calendar year with two modules. The first module for all participants is the University of Wollongong subject 'Effective Leadership in Health'. The second module is a choice of either Effective Leadership in Practice (ELP) or Clinical Leadership Program (CLP).

The programs aim to support participants to:

- Enhance effective leadership capabilities
- Develop and apply key behaviours, skills and practices to lead cultures to deliver safe, quality, compassionate and person centred care.
- Enhance confidence in leadership of self, others and teams.

#### What will I learn?

This leadership program is designed to help individuals work with their own values and behaviours to become more effective at leading their team members to provide coordinated and effective care.

The program uses an academic framework to stimulate enquiry and to promote the use of evidence in all aspects of work. A workshop format is used, and there is a combination of theoretical sessions and active learning activities. Participants experience working with tools that are designed to develop leadership skills and build cultures of quality and safety.

#### Who can apply?

The program is open to all staff in SESLHD. You do not need to be in a management or senior role to apply.

- You must be a permanent employee of the district and either a citizen or permanent resident of Australia.
- You must also meet the academic entry requirements for the University of Wollongong—generally this means you will hold a bachelor level degree or equivalent.







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## Do I get a qualification for completing this program?

Following successful completion of the program, participants receive 12 credit points with the University of Wollongong toward a Graduate Certificate in Health Leadership & Management – this can also be put toward a Master's Degree in Health Leadership and Management.
