The content of the day includes;

- Introduction to some of the key effective models of leadership
- Incorporating strengths & resilience to build Leadership capacity
- Identifying strategies to develop own leadership style within your own setting
- Exploring ways of positively influencing workplace culture by developing teams and enabling others through Compassionate Leadership
- Leading safe, person centred and integrated care
- Allowing time for critical reflection and create opportunities for effective networking

All participants are offered one on one coaching / mentoring opportunities post workshop to support with goal attainment and ongoing leadership development. Leadership resources from workshop are distributed post attendance
