

What vaccinations and blood tests do I need?

Evidence is required for the following:

- Adult dose of **dTpa** (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis) within last 10 years
- Age-appropriate course of **Hepatitis B** vaccine - Usually 3 doses. For adolescents between 11-15 years - 2 adult doses is acceptable. If evidence not available – revaccination will be required or a Hep B Statutory Declaration (see p46 of the [Occupational Assessment, Screening & Vaccination Policy](#)).
- **Hep B serology** showing immunity (anti-HBs > 10IU/ml **OR** positive anti-HBc)
- Two doses of **MMR** (measles, mumps, rubella) at least 28 days apart **OR** serology showing immunity to all 3 diseases **OR** Birth date before 1966
- Age-appropriate course of **Varicella** vaccine (adults – 2 doses at least 28 days apart, If given at age 14 or less - only 1 dose required) **OR** serology showing immunity - **History of Chicken Pox is not acceptable** as evidence
- A TB screen (TST or IGRA)) may be required for students who were born in or have lived in [high-risk TB countries](#) for a cumulative total of 3 months or more.
