## What vaccinations and blood tests do I need?

## **Evidence** is required for the following:

- Adult dose of **dTpa** (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis) within last 10 years
- Age-appropriate course of Hepatitis B vaccine Usually 3 doses. For adolescents between 11-15 years 2 adult doses is acceptable. If evidence not available revaccination will be required or a Hep B Statutory Declaration (see p46 of the Occupational Assessment, Screening & Vaccination Policy).
- **Hep B serology** showing immunity (anti-HBs > 10IU/ml **OR** positive anti-HBc)
- Two doses of MMR (measles, mumps, rubella) at least 28 days apart OR serology showing immunity to all 3 diseases OR Birth date before 1966
- Age-appropriate course of Varicella vaccine (adults 2 doses at least 28 days apart,
  If given at age 14 or less only 1 dose required) OR serology showing immunity History of Chicken Pox is not acceptable as evidence
- A TB screen (TST or IGRA)) may be required for students who were born in or have lived in <a href="https://high-risk.nih.gov/high-risk.n
