## **SAQ 8 Answers**

- a) Dose > 300mg/kg Tachypnoea
- b) ABG Salicylate level BSL
- c) Avoid acidosis give Sodium Bicarbonate prior to intubation Hyperventilate once intubated Avoid long acting muscle relaxants to monitor for seizure activity
- D) Unable to maintain urinary alkalinisation
  Serum salicylate levels increasing (> 4.4 mmol/L) despite optimal medical treatment
  Altered mental status, acidaemia, renal failure
  Very high salicylate levels Acute > 7.2mmol/L, Chronic > 4.4mmol/L
