SAQ6

A 68 yr old female presents to your Emergency Department following a fall. She complains of a painful left wrist. You have been asked by the orthopaedic team to manipulation and plaster this injury in the Emergency Department.

a. List 6 positive findings on the patient's wrist x-ray (6 Marks)

1/2 Mark each for:

- Fractured distal radius
 - Comminuted
 - o Intra-articular
 - Impaction / shortening
 - Volar / palmar angulation
- Ulna styloid fracture

b. List 2 negative findings on the patient's wrist x-ray (2Mark)

- No splint / POP visible
- Nil soft tissue deficit / laceration noted
- Ni lair visible in soft tissue
- Nil rings noted
- Nil destructive bony lesion

c. List 6 factors that would positively influence your decision to perform the manipulation in the Emergency Department 6 Marks)

- Patient factors
 - Neurovascular compromise
 - Consents to reduction in ED
 - o Fasted if procedural sedation considered
 - No contraindication to proposed reduction method
- Department Factors
 - o Appropriate skill mix available
 - o Equipment available
 - o Area available
- System factors
 - Delay in theatre

d. List 6 factors that would negatively influence your decision to perform the manipulation in the Emergency Department (3 Marks)

1/2 Mark each up to 3 marks from:

- Patient factors
 - o Patient has no compromise and comfortable
 - o Refusal for reduction in ED
 - Significant co-morbidities
 - Airway risk
 - Not fasted
 - o Clear indication for immediate OT e.g. open #, compartment syndrome
- Department Factors
 - Busy department
 - Unsuitable skill mix
 - o Equipment not available
 - Space not available
 - o Time of day e.g. overnight
- System factors
 - o Unlikely to be definitive Tx Smith's fracture high likelihood of slip and need for ORIF
