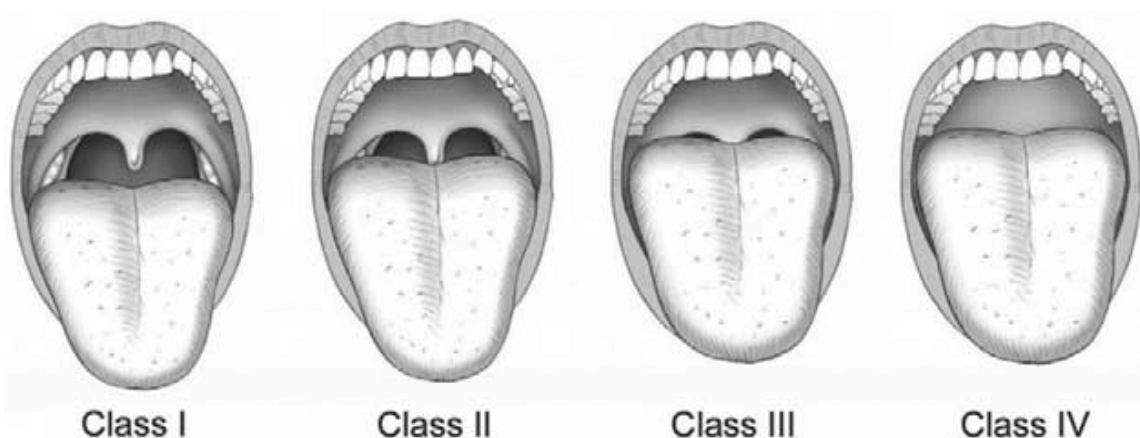

Pre-procedure:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Is the procedure necessary? Is the Emergency Department the safest place for this procedure? Does the area have the appropriate resources? (equipment/ monitoring/ staffing) 		
Patient Assessment:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> AMPLE History (allergies, medications, PMHx, last ate, events) Consider ASA status Difficult airway evaluation (LEMON, BONES) Prior problems with anaesthesia / sedation Patient weight Informed consent obtained 		
Monitoring		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Continuous Pulse Ox End-tidal CO2 ECG BP – 3-5 min cycle 		
Equipment		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Oxygen via NRBM Suction Airway adjuncts Resus trolley with defibrillator 		
Medication		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Appropriate choice of medication, dose calculated Appropriate IV access 1L bag fluids on pump set 		
Procedure		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Level 3 checklist completed Staff briefed Desired level of sedation achieved Adverse events managed appropriately

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Mallampati Score:



ASA rating
I. Normal healthy patient
II. Mild systemic disease
III. Severe systemic disease limiting activity but not incapacitating
IV. Incapacitating systemic disease that is a constant threat to life
V. Moribund, not expected to survive with or without the operation

LEMON Difficult Laryngoscopy: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Look externally• Evaluate 3-3-2 rule• Mallampati score• Obstruction• Neck mobility	BONES Difficult BVM: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Beard• Obese• No teeth• Elderly• Sleep apnoea / snoring
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
