Services are moving into the new Acute Services Building from early 2023

The new building, known as the Acute Services Building, changes the location of some services at Prince of Wales Hospital, Randwick. Signage is in place in and around the Randwick Hospitals Campus to direct you where to go.

Services not identified on Figure A will remain in the existing buildings – be sure to confirm the location and directions to the service you're visiting with your treating team.

Please pay close attention to traffic and pedestrian signs when entering and moving around the campus as some construction work is still underway.

How to get to the new Adult Emergency Department

The Adult Emergency Department will be located on level B2 of the new Acute Services Building. The public dropoff and pick-up zone for the new Emergency Department is located off Magill Street, via Botany Street.

How to get to the new main entrance

The main entrance to the Acute Services Building is located at 77 Botany Street, opposite UNSW. The new hospital building can also be accessed from the existing buildings via a public link bridge. The link bridge is accessible via level 0 of the existing campus, adjacent to the Royal Hospital for Women entrance. We recommend allowing extra travel time to find your way around the new hospital.

Arriving by car

Park in the Randwick Hospitals Campus car park (Point Parking), accessed from Easy Street (off Barker Street). Take the lift up to level 0 and follow the signs to the Acute Services Building. This will take you through the public link bridge, connecting the existing hospital campus to the new building.

The link bridge will connect you to the main public entrance on level 0. Take the lift to the floor you need to go to, or ask for directions at the Information Desk or use our new digital wayfinding kiosks.

Arriving by public transport

Alight from the Light Rail at the UNSW stop on High Street and turn right into Botany Street. You'll find the main entrance to the new Acute Services Building on the left, before Magill Street. Information about bus routes can be found on the Prince of Wales Hospital website.

The first stage of the Randwick Campus Redevelopment includes a contemporary, 13-storey Acute Services Building, providing a major expansion and upgrade of essential adult health services at Prince of Wales Hospital.


The Acute Services Building includes a new and expanded Emergency Department, Intensive Care Unit, digital operating theatres and five levels of inpatient units with additional beds.
