

Eligible patients and carers are entitled to obtain concessional rates for car parking.

Those eligible must be visiting a patient in a public hospital or have an appointment on the Campus at a service operated by NSW Health.

Who is eligible for concessional car parking?

Those eligible must be visiting a patient in a public hospital or have an appointment on the Campus at a service operated by NSW Health. Patients and carers eligible to obtain concession rates when parked in public hospital car parks include:

- (a) holders of eligible government cards (Identification must be in the form of the applicable government issued permit or card).
- (b) patients and their carers who attend the hospital/facility on an ongoing basis for treatment for a chronic illness or lifetime treatment

Others may be eligible.

How do you claim your concession rate?

Eligible patients, their carers, and holders of concession cards are required to present their parking ticket, photo identification and concession card or request for concessional rates at one of the following hospital administrative points prior to exiting the car park:

- Information Desk (Enquiry Counter), Barker Street entrance (8am-8pm, 7 days a week)
- After hours, please visit the Point Parking Office, B1, Main Car Park

Concession Rates

0-3 hours FREE

3 plus hours \$6.80 one exit only per 24 hours

3 day ticket \$13.50 frequent use allowing multiple entries and exits in a 3 day period
7 day ticket \$27.10 frequent use allowing multiple entries and exits in a 7 day period
