Bringing Bexsero (Meningococcal B) Vaccine to the Clinic:



What You Need to Know



Before your appointment

- ✓ Book a vaccination appointment (1300 244 288)
- ✓ Inform the Public Health Unit (PHU) (9382 8333, press option 2) you'll be bringing the vaccine with you
- ✓ Follow their instructions (below) so the vaccine stays safe and works well
- Get a script from your doctor
- Order the vaccine from your pharmacy for pick up on appointment day



Day of appointment

- ☑ Bring an insulated cooler bag with a small ice brick wrapped in bubble wrap or a small cloth to the pharmacy.
 - Ice brick should be cold but not frozen solid (otherwise it can damage the vaccine)
- Put the vaccine (in its **original box**) on top of the covered ice brick in the cooler bag. This will protect it from light and keep it at the right temperature.

- Go directly from the pharmacy to the clinic
 - It's best if the vaccine is given within 1–2 hours after buying it.
- ✓ Tell the receptionist or nurse you have a vaccine with you.
 - They will make sure it is stored the right way before your child gets the vaccine.



Important tips

- ✓ **Never leave the vaccine** in a hot car, handbag, or in the sun.
- ✓ If the vaccine is **damaged** or **not stored properly**, it might not work and **you may need a new one**.
- We cannot give the vaccine if it has been stored in your fridge at home.
