The Royal Hospital for Women (RHW) is now a highly active research institution, in all areas of perinatal care. A large number of staff, from midwifery, obstetrics, neonatal nursing and neonatology have contributed to this research activity. Perinatal Academic Group (PAG) was developed at the RHW (November 2011) to review new trial applications, discuss resource implications and oversee a research strategy for the future. PAG meetings act to ensure that conflict between research studies and recruitment is minimised by having oversight of all current internal and external research. It does not aim to provide an additional barrier to perinatal research at the RHW. Members of the PAG are happy to advise on study conduct and design should this be required, as well as availability of resources at the Royal.
