	Assessment and management of acutely unwell/deteriorating older persons residing in residential aged care facility where hospital transfer is being considered.
	All referrals are triaged when phoned through to GFS. Depending on service demand and staffing, residents are reviewed within 2-4 hours.
WHO TO REFER	 A person who: Is living in a RACF. Has an acute deterioration. Has consent of GP (or if GP uncontactable/unavailable and client/family consent for referral obtained) Hospital transfer is being considered. Exclusion Criteria: Emergency Conditions in which a person may not be able to wait 2 hours (i.e. Myocardial Infarction or hemodynamic instability and for active intervention). Surgical issues. Resident and/or family member want hospital transfer and that is appropriate for condition.
