DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE	This is a Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) auspiced by Southcare.
	The Dementia Home Monitoring Program provides practical low level in home support including meal and medication supervision, assistance/prompting with personal care, shopping, transport to appointments (e.g. GPs, hairdressers) and supervised social outings.
	The Dementia Home Monitoring Program is coordinated by a Registered Nurse who assesses and develops a care plan for the client in consultation with the client/carer and/or family. Community Support workers and/or the Coordinator then visit clients to provide the care at home. The program operates in conjunction with other community support services (e.g. Home Care, Neighbour Aid, Meals on Wheels, Dementia Day Care, etc.). The Coordinator also provides support, dementia care information, advice and education for family carers of clients' on the program.
WHO TO REFER	A resident of the Sutherland Shire with a dementing illness who requires low level support to remain living at home.
