DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE	The Cottage is Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) funded program auspiced by Southcare.
	The Cottage is a day care centre for people with a diagnosed dementing illness and low level care needs. It provides social activities in a secure group environment and regular respite for the carer/family.
	Potential clients are assessed by the Coordinator at home to determine if the centre can meet their needs.
	The Cottage has the capacity to care for 15 clients per day (reduced to 9 clients – COVID-19 restrictions). The Cottage staff consists of a Registered Nurse Coordinator, Assistant in Nursing, Diversional Therapist and a Bus Driver/General Assistant.
	The Cottage is located at the back of the Southcare building on the Sutherland Hospital campus. Transport to and from The Cottage is available.
WHO TO REFER	A resident of the Sutherland Shire with a dementing illness and low level care needs, who is socially isolated and/or whose carer requires regular day respite.

REFERRAL CRITERIA	Residents of the Sutherland Shire (or residing with) living in their own home who are frail or disabled and require ongoing low level support to live at home.
	Exclusion Criteria: 1. Residential care
	2. Group homes
	 ACCR or NSAF approval for high level (3&4) Home Care Package and / or Residential Aged Care (check with co-ordinator)
IS THERE A WAITING LIST	At times – phone coordinator to check
WAITING LIST DETAILS	The Coordinator will phone the client/carer to advise.
HOURS/DAYS OF OPERATION	8.30am – 4:30pm Monday to Friday
APPROXIMATE COST	Donation of \$20.00 per day (or as per the activities program) which includes transport to and from The Cottage, morning tea, lunch and centre based activities.
