This program is the only Graduate Certificate in Ophthalmic Nursing in Australia. It equips students with knowledge of the physiology of the human eye, diseases which affect the eye, and clinical management of people with co-morbidities, as well as the skills to conduct assessments, interpret data and make sound judgements in a clinical setting. Students also develop their capacity to collaborate and problem-solve with multidisciplinary teams within the context of ophthalmic nursing.

This Graduate Certificate in Ophthalmic Nursing has been specifically designed for registered nurses who wish to learn more about the specialised treatment and care of people with ophthalmic disorders.

The Graduate Certificate in Ophthalmic Nursing is studied part-time over one year. The program consists of four courses, taught via a combination of online, intensive, and face-to-face learning at Notre Dame's Sydney Campus:

- Ophthalmic Nursing 1
- Ophthalmic Nursing 2
- Evidence Based Practice and Research

Students also complete a minimum of 14 days professional workplace experience.
