Mac OS X Quick start guide

Citrix Netscaler Thin Client delivers remote access to Citrix Published Applications and Windows VPN desktop for privately owned "BYOD" bring your own devices.

This *quick start* guide covers what you need to know to get started including:

- Symantec Secure VIP Access client install and Credential ID registration
- Citrix Receiver client install for Mac OS X operating system
- Old IX Necester cheffe histori for Mac 65 X 6p
- Citrix Access Gateway Log On
- Launch Published Applications or VPN Desktop
- Citrix Access Gateway Log Off

- Select the Applications tab
- Click your published **Application** icon

VPN Desktop

Select the **Desktops** tab

How to Disconnect

Published Applications

- Close or log off your Application
- Your Citrix Netscaler Thin Client session will close and return to your Citrix Access Gateway session

Tip: Click Main in the Applications tab to navigate back to the main menu

VPN Desktop

- Close all open Applications
- Click Start then Log Off
- Your Citrix Netscaler Thin Client session will close and return to your Citrix Access Gateway session

Tip: Click Main in the Applications tab to navigate back to the main menu

Citrix Access Gateway

- Ensure all published Application and VPN
 Desktop sessions are closed
- Click Log Off in the grey toolbar in the upper right of screen
- Close your browser window
