Your visit to the adult Outpatient Department at Prince of Wales Hospital

We thank you for your patience.

Our Outpatient Department provides a service for a large number of patients from across Sydney and NSW. Due to the large number of patients who use this service unexpected delays can arise.

It is important that you check in at the reception desk as soon as you arrive in the Department.

As we cannot guarantee what time you will be seen, we advise that you do not make any other commitments after your appointment. If you need to reschedule your appointment please contact the Outpatient Department on **(02) 9382 0400**.

Please note, Prince of Wales is a teaching hospital so you may not be seen by a consultant doctor but alternatively a registrar from the speciality medical team.

What to bring

We suggest you bring along activities to keep you entertained while waiting (for example, a book, music player with headphones, crosswords). There is also a television and magazines available in the waiting area.

If you have any particular medical needs we suggest you come prepared (for example, bring your medications, if you are diabetic please bring food).

To avoid missing your appointment we suggest you collect refreshments from the cafes located in the foyer of the hospital before checking in. If you need to leave the waiting area for any reason please inform staff at the reception desk.

As there is limited seating space, please bring along only one support person (for example, a family member, friend, or carer) with you.

To help you find your way, please bring this information flyer which has a map.

Parking/ transport options

Car parking is available via the Barker Street, Randwick entrance of Prince of Wales Hospital and is managed by Metro Parking. For more information, please call: 9326 7233 or see: www.metroparking.com.au/cms-new-south-wales/randwick-campus.phps

Street parking near the hospital is restricted. Please ensure you park in a space with a minimum of a two hour time limit.

Limited parking for people with disability permits are available at the High Street and Barker Street entrances of Prince of Wales Hospital.

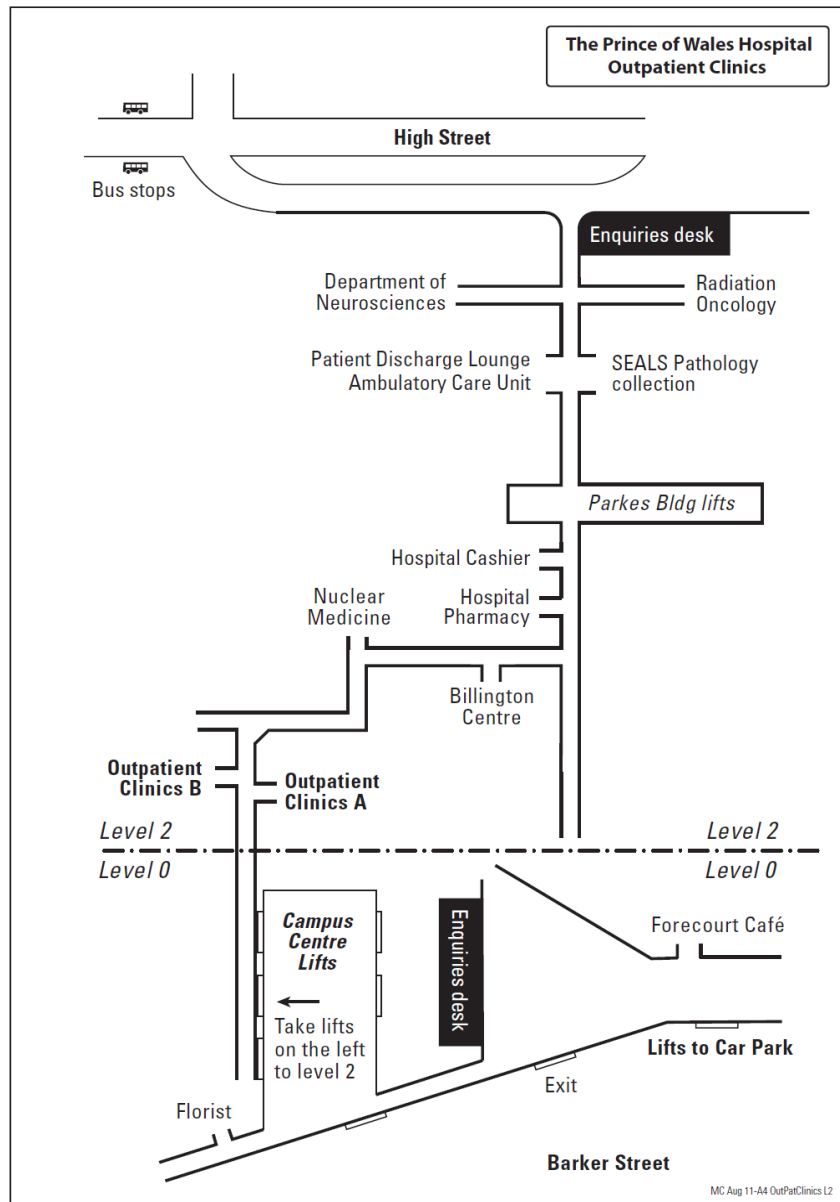
Patients can also be dropped off or collected at either the Barker Street or High Street entrances. Please note -the Barker Street entrance is the closest entrance to the Outpatient Department.
